Dashboard staging date: Discussion

Introduction

- 1. DWP have outlined their proposals under the dashboard for the order and timing of when schemes will be able to connect to the pension dashboard.
- 2. They are now asking for feedback on these proposals via the <u>call for input</u> which will close on Friday 9 July.

DWP Proposals

- 3. Dashboards should increase engagement and individual awareness of pension savers¹.
- 4. First wave to commence from April 2023 over period of two years.
- 5. Pensions coverage is important to DWP, 99% of entitlement achieved from schemes with 1000+ members.
- 6. Public service pension schemes represent a significant portion of members (nearly 20% of all active and deferred memberships in scope for dashboards).
- 7. Public sector schemes to be included in cohort three of first wave.
- 8. Keen for public sector schemes to onboard as early as possible within first wave, ideally from late 2023.
- 9. Paragraphs 88 to 91 deal with Public Service schemes.
- 10. Further engagement necessary to recognise what McCloud means for public sector savers.

For discussion

- 11. What needs to be available on the dashboard to give value for Firefighters?
- 12. Is it expected that value for Firefighters would be different or the same as value for other types of savers?
- 13. Are there differences within the membership of different perceptions of value, e.g between wholetime and on-call Firefighters?

- 15. What would the impact be if the dashboard could not initially reflect McCloud due to an early staging date?

- 17. What is the earliest that public service schemes could reasonably be expected to connect?"
- 18. Should locally administered Fire schemes be treated as one scheme with excess of 1000+ members, or individually by size?
