Update on budget and provision of secretariat

Current Position

- 1. The minister has approved the submitted board budget of £136,062.50, which includes the provision for a full time post with LGA to provide board secretariat support and act as communications officer.
- In order to collect the monies from Fire Authorities, LGA need a signed agreement between LGA and the Firefighters' Pension Scheme (England) Advisory Board. This is going through the relevant legal channels to be drafted.
- Once the agreement has been signed and the process put in place to collect the monies from FRAs, LGA can begin the recruitment process for the full time post.
- 4. The budget paper submitted to the minister had an indicative amount of £4.05 per firefighter member, based on figures provided by GAD at March 2015 which confirmed there were 33,611 active firefighters.
- 5. As the exact numbers of firefighters at 1st October 2016 are unknown, I propose to invoice the FRAs at a rate of £2.07 per active firefighter from the period 1st October. This is based on an estimated current total of 33,000 active firefighters, and any adjustments will be credited in the 2017/2018 year.
- 6. The minister agreed to bring the technical adviser role, which is £2 per firefighter within the levy. This will be included in the levy from 1st April 2017.
- 7. The 2017/2018 year will be collected on the numbers of firefighters disclosed with the 2016/2017 return.
- 8. For the 2016/2017 year, the levy and agreement will commence from 1st October, which allows the board to cover estimated salary costs, full expenses for the board and have £32,000 for the board's use before the end of the financial year.
